# Why Seaweed Farming?



***Aim: To create a financially viable, environmentally sustainable and socially beneficial seaweed business.***

- People and place – sustainable community - local benefits
- Environmental benefits – Absorbs Carbon Dioxide and Nitrogen, leaves wild stocks alone
- Site at Bendoran – access to the sea, space for necessary infrastructure
- Market opportunities – biorefinery, bioplastics, aquaculture, food

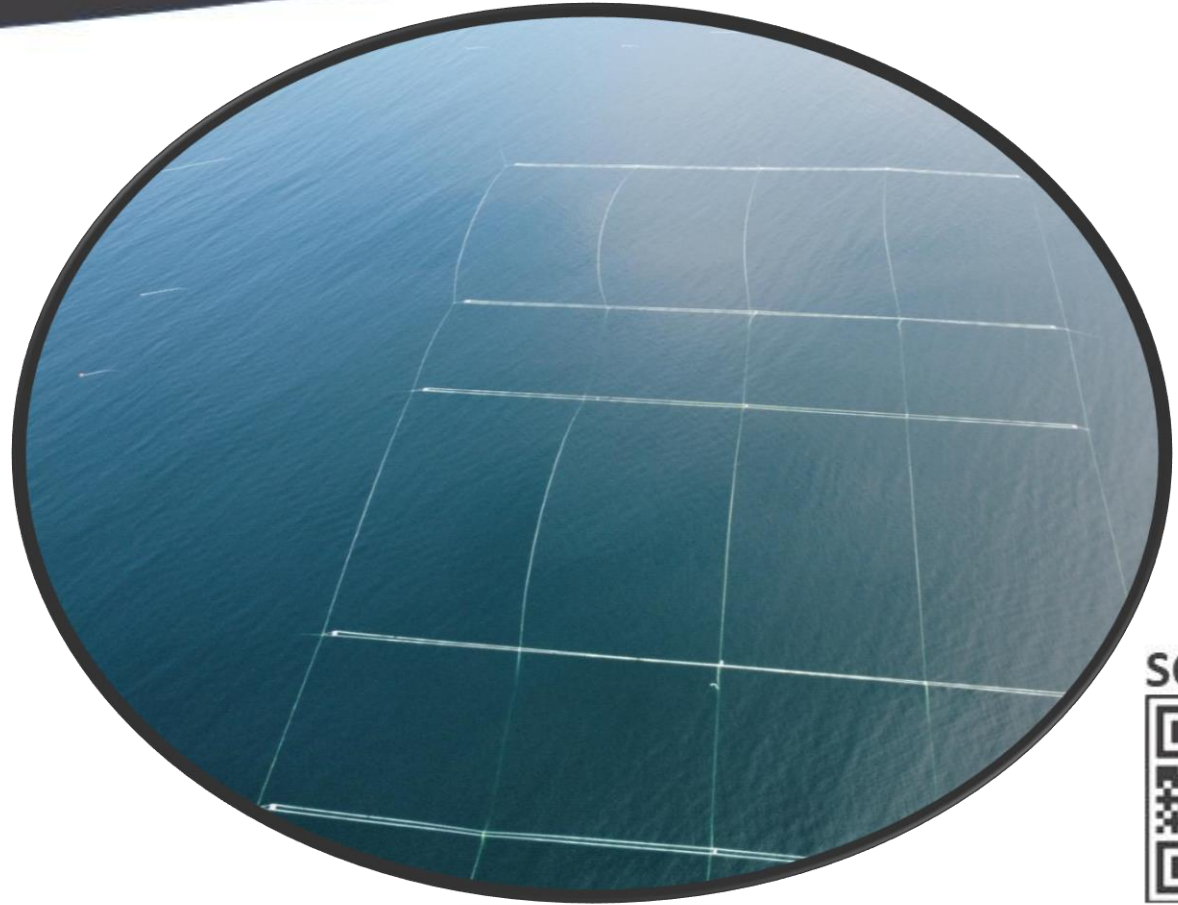

# How it worked (or should have)...

- 6ha Farm – 3 x 2ha rectangles
- 6km seeded line (Saccharina Latissima)
- Deployed over 2 weeks – 1 day per week
- 6 people, local fishing boat and a rib
- 1 section of site leased to another individual in return for skills and help.
- Fortnightly checks and assessment
- Harvest in April/May
